


## Q1 Is parking a deterrent for you to shop downtown?



## Q2 Is parking a deterrent for you to dine downtown:



The service would pick up from a free parking lot located about 1/2 mile from downtown.



## Q4 Would you use the Park and Ride service if you were required to summon the shuttle via call, text, or phone app?



## Q5 What would you consider is a reasonable wait time for pick-up?



## Q6 If you would use this service, how many days per week would you likely do so?





## Q8 If additional golf cart specific parking spaces were available in the downtown area, would you be more likely to visit downtown via your cart?


